Dear Mr. Feore:

On October 12, 2011 we stopped the clock on considering the license assignment applications related to the transaction designed to bring the Tribune Companies out of bankruptcy with retroactive effect to July 26, 2010 (Day 74).¹ On July 23, 2012, the bankruptcy court issued an order confirming the Fourth Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization for the Tribune Companies (the "Plan"). Without further order of the court, the Plan may go into effect on August 6. We will therefore restart the clock effective August 6 at Day 75.
