REPORT AND ORDER
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: January 19, 1989; Released: February 8, 1989

By the Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division:

1. Pursuant to the request of Clifford Jones (petitioner) the Commission has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 3 FCC Rcd 3111 (1988), proposing the allotment of FM Channel 296A to Waynesboro, Georgia, as that community's second FM service. Petitioner filed comments in support of the *Notice*. No other comments were received.

2. Channel 296A can be allotted to Waynesboro in compliance with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements with a site restriction of 2.2 kilometers (1.4 miles) north to avoid a short spacing to Station WCLA-FM, Claxton, Georgia, operating on Co-Channel 296A.¹

3. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting Channel 296A to Waynesboro, Georgia, since an interest has been expressed in providing the community with its second local FM service. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective March 27, 1989, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, to read as follows:

City	Channel No.
Waynesboro, Georgia	265A, 296A

4. The window period for filing applications will open on March 28, 1989, and close on April 27, 1989.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
