## AN ACT

To amend the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, with respect to painting, illumination, and dismantlement of radio towers.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That section 303 (q) of the Communications Act of 1934  
4 (47 U.S.C. 303 (q)) is amended by inserting after the  
5 period at the end thereof the following: "The permittee or  
6 licensee shall maintain the painting and/or illumination of  
7 the tower as prescribed by the Commission pursuant to this  
8 section. In the event that the tower ceases to be licensed  
9 by the Commission for the transmission of radio energy,  
10 the owner of the tower shall maintain the prescribed painting

1 and/or illumination of such tower until it is dismantled, and  
2 the Commission may require the owner to dismantle and  
3 remove the tower when the Administrator of the Federal  
4 Aviation Agency determines that there is a reasonable pos-  
5 sibility that it may constitute a menace to air navigation.”
