WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUREAU TO CONDUCT ANOTHER UNIVERSAL LICENSING SYSTEM (ULS) INTERACTIVE DEMONSTRATION ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1999

Demonstration to be Held at FCC's Gettysburg, PA Office

The Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) will conduct another interactive demonstration of its Universal Licensing System (ULS) on September 16, 1999. WTB also is seeking comments and suggestions from those interested in attending the demonstration in order to better coordinate and design the event.

ULS is a new, interactive licensing system developed by the Bureau to consolidate and replace eleven existing licensing systems used to process applications and grant licenses in wireless services. ULS provides numerous benefits, including fast and easy electronic filing, improved data accuracy through automated edit checking of applications, and enhanced electronic access to licensing information.

WTB will hold the demonstration, which will provide an example of a Microwave filing, in the Training Room at the FCC's office located at 1270 Fairfield Road, Gettysburg, PA (directions from the Washington, DC area to the FCC's Gettysburg, PA office are included in this Public Notice as Appendix A). Individuals will be directed to the Training Room upon signing in at the front desk. The topic for the morning session, which will run from 9:30 am until noon, is Finding Information in ULS (License Search and Application Search). The topic for the afternoon session, which will run from 1:30 pm until 4:00 pm, is General License Filings.

WTB chose the above topics based on comments from the demonstrations held in March, April, May, June and July, and will add, delete or modify future demonstrations as interest dictates. WTB plans to hold ULS demonstrations on additional wireless services as they are deployed. Comment also is requested on future topics for the demonstrations.
