FCC AND NATOA ANNOUNCE WORKSHOP ON DAS / SMALL CELL DEPLOYMENT

By this Public Notice, the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB) and the National Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors (NATOA) announce the date, time, and location of a workshop on the deployment of distributed antenna systems (DAS) and small cells. The workshop will be webcast.

The upcoming workshop will include panel discussions of DAS and small cells focusing on:

- Technical/Engineering and Business Overview;
- Deployment and Uses; and
- City Case Studies.
