By the Chief, Media Bureau:

- 1. On February 1, 2008, the Commission released a Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the above-captioned docket.¹ On July 9, 2008, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued a Notice stating that it disapproved of the information collection requirements associated with the 2008 Leased Access Order.² On August 26, 2008, on behalf of the United Church of Christ, Office of Communication, Inc. (UCC), the Media Access Project (MAP) filed a request that the Commission override the OMB Notice, and "that the Commission modify its calculation for leasing a full channel."³
- 2. Due to the passage of time, UCC has agreed to withdraw its request. Therefore, we are dismissing the request without prejudice.
- 3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the UCC request filed in this docket IS DISMISSED without prejudice.
- 4. This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated by section 0.283 of the Commission's rules.⁴
