WIRELINE COMPETITION BUREAU ANNOUNCES EFFECTIVE DATE OF RESTORING INTERNET FREEDOM ORDER

WC Docket No. 17-108

With this Public Notice, the Wireline Competition Bureau announces the effective date of the *Restoring Internet Freedom Declaratory Ruling, Report and Order, and Order (Order)* is June 11, 2018.¹

The Commission adopted the *Order* on December 14, 2017.² The *Order* stated that the "Declaratory Ruling, Report and Order, and Order, including those amendments which contain new or modified information requirements [subject to Office of Management and Budget (OMB) approval under the Paperwork Reduction Act (PRA)] WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE upon the effective date announced when the Commission publishes a notice in the Federal Register announcing such OMB approval and the effective date." OMB approved the revised information requirements on May 2, 2018, and notice was published in the Federal Register on May 11, 2018. Accordingly, the *Order*, including the refinements to the transparency rule, the reclassification of broadband Internet access service as an information service, the reinstatement of the private mobile service classification of mobile broadband Internet access service, and the elimination of the conduct rules imposed by the *Title II Order*, will become effective on June 11, 2018.
