
Dear Chairman Genachowski:

As Chair of the Federal Communications Commission's Advisory Committee on Diversity for Communications in the Digital Age ("the Committee"), I present you with the Committee's final recommendation under its current charter. This recommendation was approved at our December 2, 2010 meeting and the Committee believes the recommendation will provide opportunities for minorities and women to own radio and television stations.

The recommendation proposes that the Commission adopt a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to enhance ownership diversity by allowing a company to acquire more than the otherwise-permissible number of stations in a market if the company establishes an incubator program to promote ownership by disadvantaged businesses. The comprehensive recommendation is attached.

In conclusion, as Chair of the Committee, I want to thank all of its members for their efforts in developing the recommendations of the past two years. We are confident that Commission approval of our recommendations will advance the Commission's goal of promoting diversity of ownership by encouraging minorities and women to seek opportunities in FCC-regulated industries. Thanks, too, to all Commission staff (particularly our Designated Federal Officer, Barbara Kreisman) for all their support of the Committee's efforts over the past two years.
