## DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR THE WORK OF THE CONFERENCE<sup>1</sup>

Agenda Item 1.7: to consider issues concerning the amateur and amateur-satellite services:

**1.7.3:** review of the terms and definitions of Article **S1** to the extent required as a consequence of changes made in Article **S25**.

**Background Information:** <u>At WRC 2000, it was proposed that a provision in Article S1 should be</u> modified. However the conference decided to only to consider changes in Article S1 as consequence of changes made in Article S25. One administration, with CEPT backing, was the basis for this issue at WRC-2000. The U.S. attempted to have this item withdrawn and succeeded in adding the provision "to the extent required as a consequence of changes made in Article S25."

**Proposal:** 

USA/ /1 NOC

**S1.56** *amateur service:* A *radiocommunication service* for the purpose of self-training, intercommunication and technical investigations carried out by amateurs, that is, by duly authorized persons interested in radio technique solely with a personal aim and without pecuniary interest.

**S1.57** *amateur-satellite service:* A *radiocommunication service* using *space stations* on earth *satellites* for the same purpose as those of the *amateur service*.

**Reasons:** At this time the U.S. does not support changes in Article S25 that would require consequential changes in the terms and definitions in Article S1.
