## Working Party 8F Working Group Vision

#### REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN OF DRAFTING GROUP 2

- 5 Drafting Group 2 met on three occasions. The group considered CPM-related matters in relation to two agenda items, 1.21 and 1.22:
- for agenda item 1.21, WG Vision is responsible for developing the response from WP8F to a liaison statement from JTG 1-6-8-9.
  - For agenda item 1.22, WG Vision will contribute text to WG Spectrum (which has overall responsibility for developing the CPM text).

### **11 Agenda item 1.21**

- 12 DG2 further developed the "Preliminary draft liaison statement" to JTG 1-6-8-9 contained in Annex
- 13 1 to attachment 9 to the report of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting (Document 8F/268-E). Documents 8F/306, 8F/306
- rev 1 and 8F/336 were considered in this work.
- 15 In order to complete the LS, WG Spectrum will need to contribute material for the answers to
- 16 questions 4 and 5 at the next meeting of WP8F.

#### 17 **Agenda item 1.22**

- DG2 considered the framework for the CPM text contained in Annex 10 to Attachment 13 to
- Document 8F/268-E. It is envisaged that WG Vision will provide the text for section 7.2.2.
- 20 Depending on the proposals of JTG 1-6-8-9, it may also supply text for the final bullet of section
- 21 7.2.3.
- 22 DG2 also considered the guidance on development of the CPM Report contained in Circular Letter
- 23 CA/81 (an extract of this document is contained in Document 8F/TEMP/119-E). This Circular letter
- does not provide specific guidance on the length of text related to a single agenda item. However, it
- is envisaged that the total length for each agenda item will need to be restricted to about 4 pages;
- therefore the contribution from WG VISION should be kept to about one page.
- 27 DG2 proposed some changes to the framework for the CPM text to DG 7 of WG Spectrum, to
- 28 reflect the discussion in WG Vision during this meeting; these are contained in annex 1 to this
- 29 report. These changes were accepted, and will be carried forward to the 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting as an
- 30 attachment to the report of WG Spectrum.
- 31 DG2 decided to defer developing text for the CPM report until the 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting of WP8F.
