1. Introduction

Doc. CEPT/ERC/CPG03(2001)5 contains the proposed CPG work breakdown as developed by the CPG Chairman in consultation with other ERC and PT Chairpersons. According to this proposed breakdown, preparation for the development of preliminary draft CEPT Briefs had been initiated by the WG FM Chairman (on those WRC agenda items where WG FM is identified as the leading group). At the last WG FM meeting in Interlaken, 29 January - 2 February 2001, the attached preliminary draft CEPT Briefs were developed and agreed and contact points/CEPT co-ordinators were proposed (to be confirmed by CPG) for each agenda item where WG FM is identified as the leading group. It is to be noted that

- For many of the attached preliminary draft CEPT Briefs only a basic skeleton was developed, the preliminary CEPT positions are in the majority of the cases TBD; for several issues it was possible to develop already at this stage a preliminary CEPT position;
- For agenda item 1.11, WG FM is the lead group, however, WG SE is requested to start the developing of preliminary draft ECP / CEPT Brief based on sharing studies. Therefore no preliminary draft CEPT Brief was developed by WG FM;
- For agenda item 1.21 no preliminary draft CEPT Brief was developed as it was felt that a discussion in CPG was needed to clarify the aim and goal of this agenda item and to reconsider the leading group for this agenda item;
- For agenda items 1.2, 1.23 and 1.36 FM PT 40 is the responsible group within WG FM, however, the FM PT 40 had no chance to discuss the preliminary draft CEPT Briefs due to the schedule of meetings.

2 WRC-2003 Agenda Items

2.13 Agenda item 1.21

To consider progress of the ITU-R studies concerning the technical and regulatory requirements of terrestrial wireless interactive multimedia applications, in accordance with Resolution 737 (WRC-2000), with a view to facilitating global harmonization

Based on discussions in FM PT 34 and WG FM on WRC-03 agenda item 1.21 it became clear that there is at present a lack of common understanding amongst participants as to how the basic objectives of this item should be reflected in a preliminary draft CEPT Brief. WG FM felt that discussion would be needed at CPG before initiating any further work on the CEPT Brief within FM PT 34, and that other ERC groups might be more appropriate to take the lead on this agenda item. It was proposed by Sweden and supported by Norway, that the item should be dealt with in a Project Team of CPG responsible for regulatory matters, as there were no allocation related issues involved.

No preliminary draft CEPT Brief was developed.

CPG is invited to discuss the issue and to take a decision on how to proceed the work on this agenda item.
