Approval of the Draft Minutes of the Last Meeting: The minutes of the 4 February meeting were approved without comment.

Consideration of Draft Preliminary Views: The following Draft Preliminary Views were presented to the meeting:

- IWG-2/004 – WRC-07 Agenda Item 1.18: to review pfd limits in the band 17.7-19.7 GHz for satellite systems using highly inclined orbits, in accordance with Resolution 141 (WRC-03);

- IWG-2/006 – WRC-07 Agenda Item 1.8 (Res. 122 (Rev. WRC-03) only): to consider the results of ITU-R studies on technical sharing and regulatory provisions for the application of high altitude platform stations operating in the bands 27.5-28.35 GHz and 31-31.3 GHz in

response to Resolution 145 (WRC-03), and for high altitude platform stations operating in the bands 47.2-46.5 GHz and 47.9-48.2 GHz in response to Resolution 122 (Rev. WRC-03).

Given that this was the first chance that the participants had a chance to see these documents, they were tabled for consideration at a future meeting.

Future Meeting: The next meeting was scheduled for 13:30-15:30 on 8 April 2004 at the offices of Leventhal, Senter & Lerman.

Other Business and Adjournment: The Chair called for any other business and seeing none the meeting was adjourned.
