Consideration of Draft Preliminary Views from Executive Branch Agencies:

-IWG-2/021 (NTIA/RCS) (Agenda Item 1.6, Res. 415). Shortly after the 5th meeting of IWG-2, the group received from the Radio Conference Subcommittee, a proposed draft preliminary view on Agenda Item 1.6 (to consider and study current satellite frequency allocations to support civil aviation telecommunications systems). In light of the fact that the NTIA and FCC reconciled the document before the CITEL PCC II meeting in July, it was decided by the group to not submit comments. The document was distributed at the meeting.

The meeting decided to not prepare a preliminary view on Agenda Item 1.7.

The Chair volunteered to contact a potentially interested US commercial interest that may wish to submit input regarding Agenda Item 1.17. Absent such input, the meeting decided to not develop a preliminary view on this agenda item.

The Chair then reviewed the WRC-07 agenda items where IWG-2 has a preliminary view. It was noted by the Chair that the agenda items where IWG-2 has a preliminary view were incorporated into the US position. By spring of 2006, all CPM text must be completed for WRC-07. IWG-2 will look to wrap up efforts by early 2006.
