Meeting Results

Introduction of Participants: Participants introduced themselves.

Agenda: The agenda was approved as presented.

Approval of Minutes of Sixth Meeting: The minutes of the September 22, 2004 meeting were approved without change.

Consideration of Draft Preliminary Views from Executive Branch Agencies:

There were no new items discussed under this agenda item. It was noted that the Government's draft Preliminary View under Agenda Item 1.17 is on the only outstanding item. The Chairman noted that the time for preparing draft Preliminary Views is ending for the most part in favor of preparation of draft conference proposals. The NTIA representative noted that it was unlikely that RCS would have any draft proposals prepared in time for submission to the next CITEL meeting, which will be held in April.

Consideration of Draft Preliminary Views/Proposals:

One new document was presented. David Weinreich of Connexion by Boeing presented Document 25 containing a draft U.S. Proposal under Agenda Item 1.6 (Resolution 415) to add an allocation for a secondary AMSS downlink to be paired with the AMSS uplink at 14-14.5 GHz. The document was discussed at some length with most comments focusing on whether such an allocation was needed and whether such allocation was intended as a means to future carriage of safety-of-life traffic by AMSS networks and an upgrade to a primary allocation. The author noted that the purpose of the proposed secondary allocation is to enable AMSS providers to secure ICAO recognition to provide a variety of non-safety-of-life services and also to provide spectrum certainty to aircraft operators.

As this was the first airing of the document, it was tabled for further consideration at the next meeting. Edits to the author were requested and a new version will be circulated in advance of the next meeting.

Future Meeting Schedule: The next meeting will be on February 3rd. If needed, a further meeting will be held on February 17th to finalize documents for the upcoming full WAC meeting.

Other Business:

There was no other business and the meeting was adjourned.
