- Don Messer, IBB and WP-6E Rapporteur for Agenda Item 1.13, presented for information a preliminary content outline as a contribution for CPM text on AI-1.13.

- A letter from George Jacobs, NASB was reviewed for information, Doc. IWG-4/27. It recognized that NASB should be represented at IWG-4.

**Other business:**

- FCC representatives provided background information relating to WRC-07 Agenda Item 1.6, and the need to protect broadcasters in the representative bands 108 MHz to 6 GHz address in this agenda item. NTIA's Draft Preliminary View was reviewed and discussed. Kris Hutchison, ARINC and Marcus Wolf, FCC discussed several existing and proposed aviation systems that were being considered for this band. No decisions were made relating to this agenda item at this meeting.
