Objectives

This Working Group will develop recommendations for the CSRIC's consideration regarding any actions the FCC should take to improve the Emergency Alert System (EAS).

- ▶ Review the FCC's rules regarding state EAS plans and recommend any actions that the Commission should take to improve the process by which state EAS plans are developed and submitted to the Commission.
 - Improve the selection and administration of State Emergency Communications Councils (SECCs).
 - Recommend methods for developing and submitting state EAS plans for FCC review in a manner that
 optimizes the effectiveness of the EAS and minimizes burdens on stakeholders, e.g., electronic filing.
 - Duration: December 2013.
- WG3 will also develop recommendations for any actions, including best practices, the Commission should take to promote the security of the EAS.
 - Duration: TBD.
- WG3 will address such other EAS-related issues as assigned to CSRIC by the FCC.
 - Duration: TBD.

Committee #1: State EAS Plans

- Develop recommendations for improving the process of developing and submitting state EAS plans by SECCs, and the FCC's review of state EAS plans.
 - Consider benefits of moving the process online.
 - Recommendations for standardizing EAS plans.
 - Duration: December 2013.

Committee #2: EAS Security

- Develop recommendations for steps to improve the security of the EAS system.
 - Duration: TBD
- Issues may include:
 - Message origination and dissemination.
 - Security of EAS Participant access.
 - Cyber hygiene best practices.
 - Engaging small entities.
 - Unauthorized EAS tones.

Committee #3: Operational Issues & Nationwide EAS Test

- Develop recommendations regarding certain operational issues that arose during the nationwide EAS test.
 - Upcoming FCC NPRM on nationwide EAS test report.
 - Duration: Depends on FCC NPRM release.
- Issues may include:
 - Uniform specs for visual crawls.
 - Test message: proper code, timing, length, dissemination.
 - Equipment performance issues.
 - Sound quality.
