**Subject:** Public Notice Announcing the 2013-2014 State Allocations for the National Deaf-Blind Equipment Distribution Program

On July 1, 2013, the FCC's Consumer and Governmental Affairs issued a Public Notice announcing the state funding allocations for the National Deaf-Blind Equipment Distribution Program (NDBEDP) for the 2013-2014 Fund year. The NDBEDP is a program mandated under the Twenty-First Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act (CVAA) that provides funding of up to \$10 million annually for the distribution of communications equipment to low-income individuals who are deaf-blind.
