Subject: NDBEDP Pilot Program Extended to June 30, 2015

On February 7, 2014, the FCC's Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau released an Order announcing the extension of the pilot program for the National Deaf-Blind Equipment Distribution Program (NDBEDP) for an additional year, until June 30, 2015. The NDBEDP was established pursuant to the Twenty-First Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act (CVAA). The CVAA authorizes the FCC to provide up to \$10 million annually for the distribution of accessible communications equipment to low-income individuals who are deaf-blind.
