Dear Mr. Young

In compliance with paragraph 15(d) of the Bell Atlantic/GTE Merger Conditions, enclosed please find reports summarizing the status of Verizon' s xDSL rollout as of December 31, 2003. The reports summarize xDSL deployment information by state, and detail the number and name/location of urban and rural wire centers and low-income wire centers where Verizon has deployed xDSL. We have denoted those states where Verizon had not triggered this condition by deploying DSL in twenty urban or rural wire centers by June 30, 2003 or the three year sunset date has been met with an "N/A" on the summary report per the response received by the FCC on February 12, 2004.

Verizon filed the 2003 quarterly status reports demonstrating compliance with this Condition on April 30, 2003, July 31, 2003, and October 30, 2003. Upon further detailed review of these reports, Verizon discovered minor discrepancies that have been corrected. As a result, please find enclosed revised first, second and third quarter 2003 reports with this filing. None of the discrepancies resulted in Verizon dropping below the required threshold.
