Meeting Results

Introduction of Participants: Participants introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes of Eighth Meeting: The minutes of the February 4, 2005 meeting were approved.

Consideration of Draft Proposals:

Steve Baruch introduced revision 1 to Document IWG-2/028, containing a draft U.S. proposal under Agenda Item 1.18 (adequacy of pfd limits for HIO non-GSO FSS satellites, including HEOs, in the 17.7-19.7 GHz band). The document was identified as having been revised to take account not only of suggestions made at the prior IWG-2 meeting, but also to “pre-reconcile” the draft proposal with a substantively similar draft proposal on the same agenda item that had been approved within the Executive Branch process. The objective was to facilitate reconciliation in order to have the draft proposal approved for transmission to CITEL’s April 2005 meeting. The meeting approved the document for submission to the April 2005 WAC meeting.

Consideration of New Draft Preliminary Views/Proposals from Exec. Branch Agencies:

Document IWG-2/032, containing the draft Executive Branch proposal for Agenda Item 1.18 for WRC-07 was considered by IWG-2. As discussed above, Revision 1 to Doc. IWG-2/028, which is IWG-2's proposal for the same agenda item, was determined to constitute the comments of IWG-2 on Document IWG-2/032.

Future Meeting Schedule: No specific date was set for the tenth meeting of IWG-2. It was agreed that the next meeting would not be scheduled until after the completion of the block of CITELE and ITU-R meetings in April to June, 2005 that could affect progress on agenda items within IWG-2's terms of reference.
