


Focus Group 1A Charter

"The Council shall present a report recommending accuracy requirements for Phase 2 and ways by which compliance with these requirements can be objectively verified."



Focus Group Structure and Report Process



- The Focus Group originally divided into subgroups to examine existing standards, public safety needs, and new technologies
- Fundamental differences of opinion about accuracy compliance persisted
- Test Area and Reporting are the major points of disagreement
- In an effort to reach consensus and collaboration, test area and reporting subgroups were formed



Results in Brief

Focus Group 1A was unable to reach consensus about Phase II accuracy testing, certification and reporting:

- The Focus Group identified several possible geographical areas for testing
 - County
 - MTA
 - Network
