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2010 Market Surveillance Report Summary

- All reports submitted have been FCC reviewed
 - All info requests have been sent by FCC
 - Last 11 RTs just sent in October
 - Next year requests will be sent much earlier
- 34 of 36 TCBs granted Certifications
- 3 TCBs submitted reports that required no follow up (9%)
 - One TCB corrected their surveillance report based on April TCBC comments without FCC request
- 14 TCBs responded acceptably to FCC information Requests (41%)
- 17 TCBs still need to respond to FCC questions (50%)
- FCC will be discussing issues with Accrediting Bodies



2010 Market Surveillance Report Summary

- Total Products Audited
 - Updated from April TCBC based on FCC follow up
 - Scope A/B – 453/11461 = 3.95%
 - RF Exposure/SAR testing - 65/4964 = 1.31%
 - Non Compliant 44/453 = 9.71%
- FCC Action Summary
 - 43 Grantees contacted
 - 6 issues not resolved
 - 22 Resolved/responded acceptably
 - 15 Grantee Codes blocked
 - One non compliance being forwarded to Enforcement Bureau



FCC Market Surveillance Policy

 - January 11, 2011 revision clarified non compliance reporting
 - June 8, 2011 revision clarified audit counting method

● Surveillance Policy Summary

- Audit 5% of Scope A/B Certifications/year
- Audit 2% of Scope C approvals/year
- Audit 1% of Certifications with SAR testing/year
- Must test products
- Audits should be performed throughout the surveillance year and not all at end or after year
- Number of audits based on grants not unique FCCIDs
- % required based on grants issued in surveillance year



FCC Market Surveillance Policy

- Non Compliance Reporting
 - Send summary to FCC easaudit@fcc.gov immediately
 - Notify Grantee immediately and determine resolution
 - Submit resolution/follow-up to FCC within 30 days
 - Submit thru “Submit Surveillance Report” link
- Annual reporting summary requirements
 - Indicate total EMC device grants and SAR device grants
 - Submit report summary for calendar year
 - Surveillance year 01/01/2011 – 12/31/2011
 - File summary thru “Submit Surveillance Report” link
 - Submit summary by January 31, 2012
 - 2011 Audit % based on 2011 authorizations
 - Don't submit details of compliant surveillances (only summary)



Audit Process

● Common Audit Issues

- Don't wait until end of surveillance period to request all audits
 - Request audit samples throughout year
- Auditing devices granted in previous years is acceptable but may lead to samples no longer being available
 - Attempt to audit more recent authorizations
- Identifying grantee surveillance obligations in TCB contract may reduce non responses.
- Ensuring grantees review grants and knowing TCB authorized may reduce non responses
 - Agents working for grantees issue grants and applicant is unaware TCB issued grant



No Response/Sample not provided

- Notify FCC of non responsive applicants or applicants unwilling to send samples
 - Not marketed in US is not valid reason for not providing sample
 - Send FCC summary of attempts made to obtain sample
 - Don't copy FCC on every correspondence
 - When a sample isn't tested it doesn't count as an audit



When Audit Doesn't Comply

- Immediately notify FCC of non compliance
 - Email to easaudit@fcc.gov
 - Included summary of non compliance
- Immediately notify Applicant
 - Work with applicant to determine resolution
- 30 Days after FCC notification send FCC update
 - Submit thru “Submit Surveillance Report” link
 - Include detailed information about issue
- TCBs work with applicant until issue resolved
 - Notify FCC of final resolution thru “Submit Surveillance Report” link
 - If not resolvable send summary to FCC identifying all attempts to resolve



2011 Surveillance Reports

- FCC Goal – Receive complete and consistent reports that we can compare and easily determine coverage and compliance rates
- Thru October 20, 2011 10255 TCB certifications
 - Only 3 TCBs have submitted surveillance follow up information for 2011 audits
 - Next annual summary due by January 31, 2011
 - Non compliance follow up due 30 days after audit
 - Very limited emails for 2011 to easaudit@fcc.gov



2011 FCC Expected Reporting Improvements

- Audit Counts based on number of authorizations issued
 - Include composites
 - Include Permissive changes
 - Indicate number of RF Exposure grants
- Devices tested in 2011 calendar year
- Adherence to follow-up procedures
 - Immediate notification to EASAUDIT@fcc.gov
 - All follow up thru “Submit Surveillance Report” Link
 - Complete follow up with applicant and notify FCC of result
- Summary list/report only for compliant surveillances
- Summaries will indicate specific tests for all audited devices
- Not necessary to submit KDB 610077 and copy of FCC selection criteria as part of report



KDB 610077 Changes

- Clarify Information in FCC Summary
 - Specify reporting period
 - Indicate total number of authorizations
 - Indicate total number of authorizations where RF Exposure testing applies
 - For all audits specify what testing performed or if all requirements tested
 - Specify testing date for each audit



Website Update

- How many grants did I issue?
 - “Grants per Year” link
 - Allows current and previous year search
 - Authorization Search based on grant line entries and not accurate for grant count
 - Total may change slightly due to dismissals
- Format of follow up emails being corrected
