Historical Data

The FCC utilizes approximately 48 to 50 - 64 gallon bins and 24- 30 gallon executive type bins.

Note: Contractors that utilize a weighing system may choose to dump the contents of the 64 and 30 gallon bins into a push cart, while servicing the building. We estimate that a full push cart weighs 175 pounds. The contractor will provide a written receipt of the total amount picked up per service to the government designated inspector. All invoices will be approved against the written receipts provided.
