On March 7, 2011, the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) awarded a contract to administer the Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) Fund to Rolka Loube Saltzer Associates (RLSA), beginning a transition period from the current TRS fund administrator, the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA). During this transition and thereafter, we authorize and direct USAC to transfer and make available to RLSA the same information and data currently provided to and shared with NECA, including records containing company-specific data.¹
