




Background

- 30 Mile Radius
- 3 MHz to 3 GHz
- Deployable and Fixed Platforms
- Validates who should be “on air”
- Provides data on who is “off air”
- Deploys at the request of FEMA during a broad spectrum of incidents

Outreach

•Public Safety, Broadcast, and Health Care Licensees

- Hospitals (Hurricane Ike)
 - Multiple patients evacuated
 - Hospital supplies delivered
 - Over 100 messages relayed
- Broadcasters
 - Assisted in finding resources for continuity of broadcasting
 - Aided in access and return to affected areas
 - Assisted in cross station temporary authorities to simulcast multiple station's content over single facilities
- Harris County PSAPs
 - Assisted in industry coordination for repair
 - Assisted in providing access and priority for temporary communications assets
