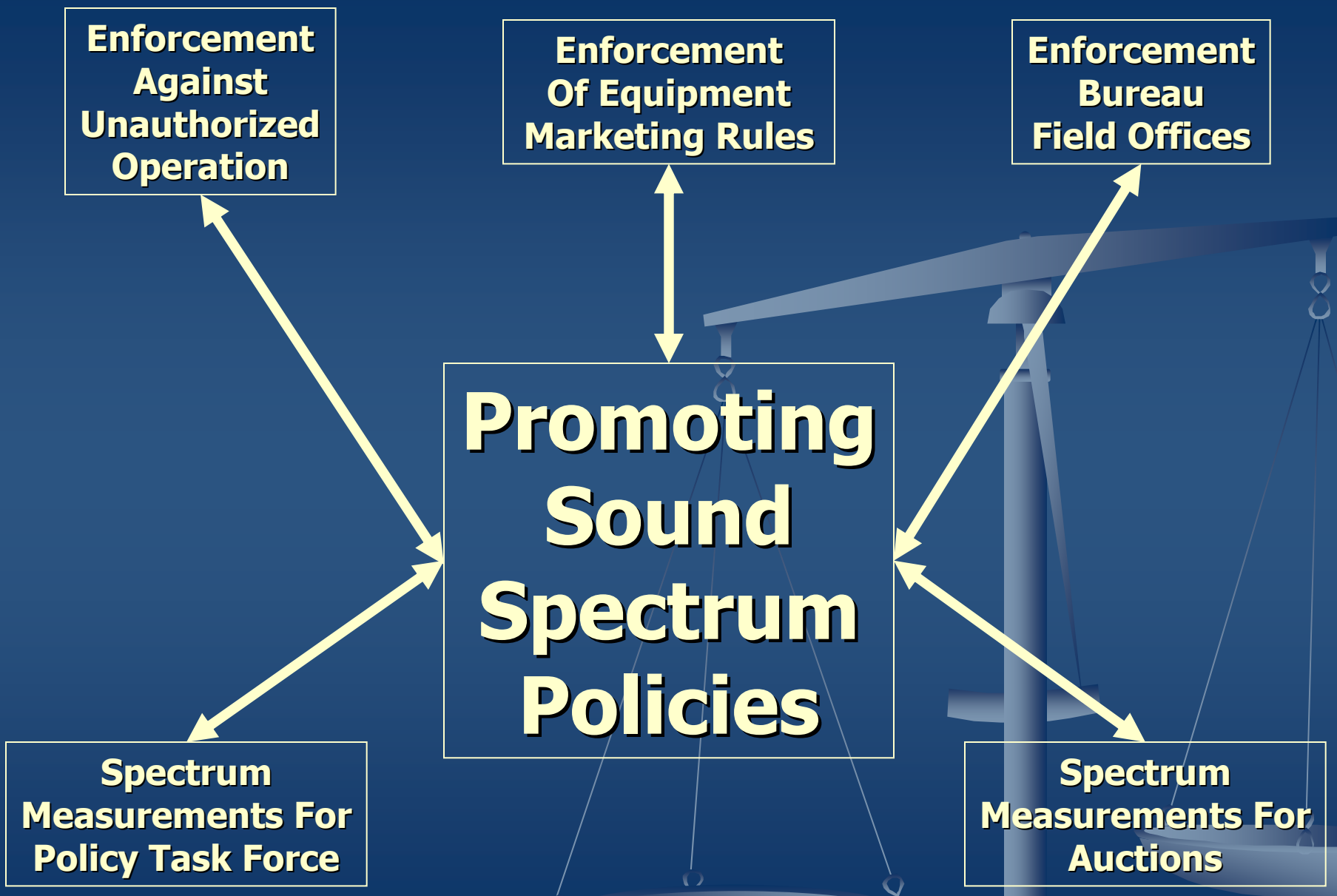

Protecting Public Safety

Major Public Safety Actions

E911	\$2.2 million in sanctions
Tower Safety Enforcement	\$1.0 million in sanctions
Emergency Alert System	\$346,000 in sanctions
AM Tower Fences	\$184,000 in sanctions
Radio Frequency Radiation	\$20,000 in sanctions
Cable Signal Leakage	\$181,000 in sanctions

Major Competition Actions in 2002

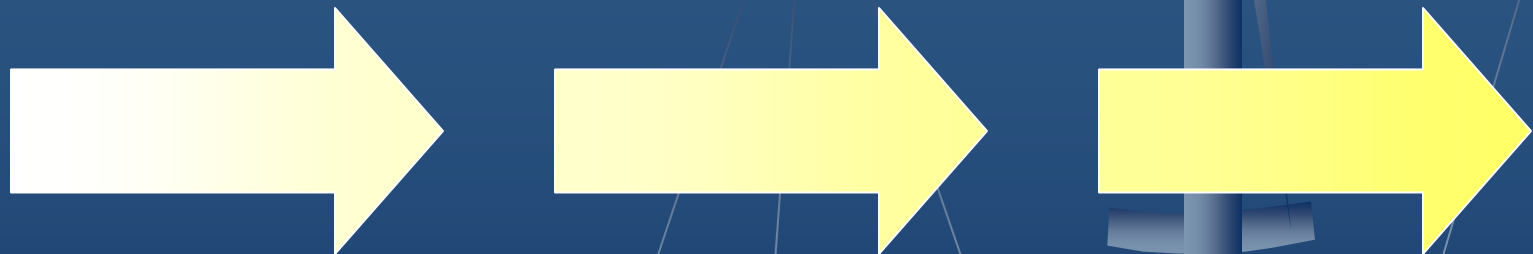
Violation of shared transport merger condition	\$6 million forfeiture
Inaccurate affidavits filed in §271 proceedings	\$3.6 million consent decree
Refusal to comply with Letter of Inquiry	\$100,000 forfeiture
Inaccurate performance reporting	\$260,000 consent decree
Violation of collocation rules	\$84,000 forfeiture
Collocation posting	\$96,000 consent decree

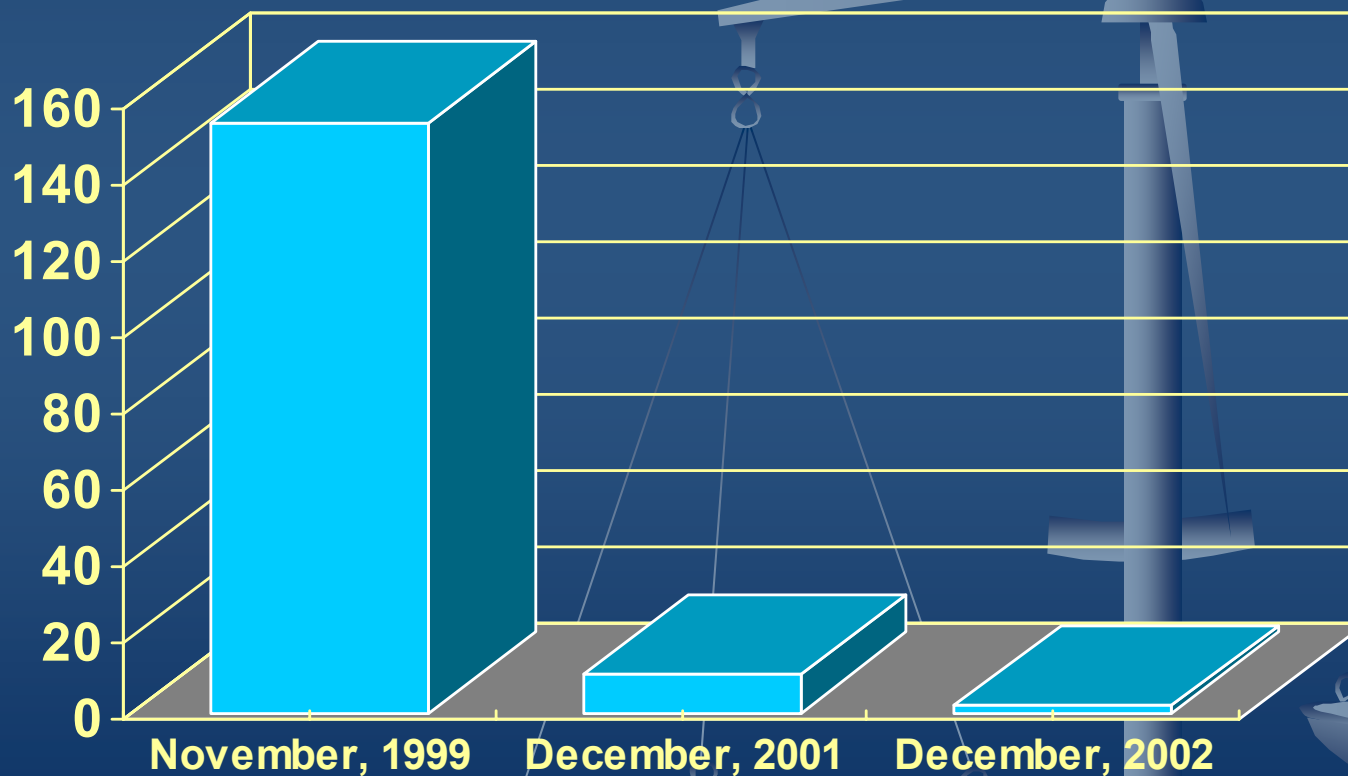

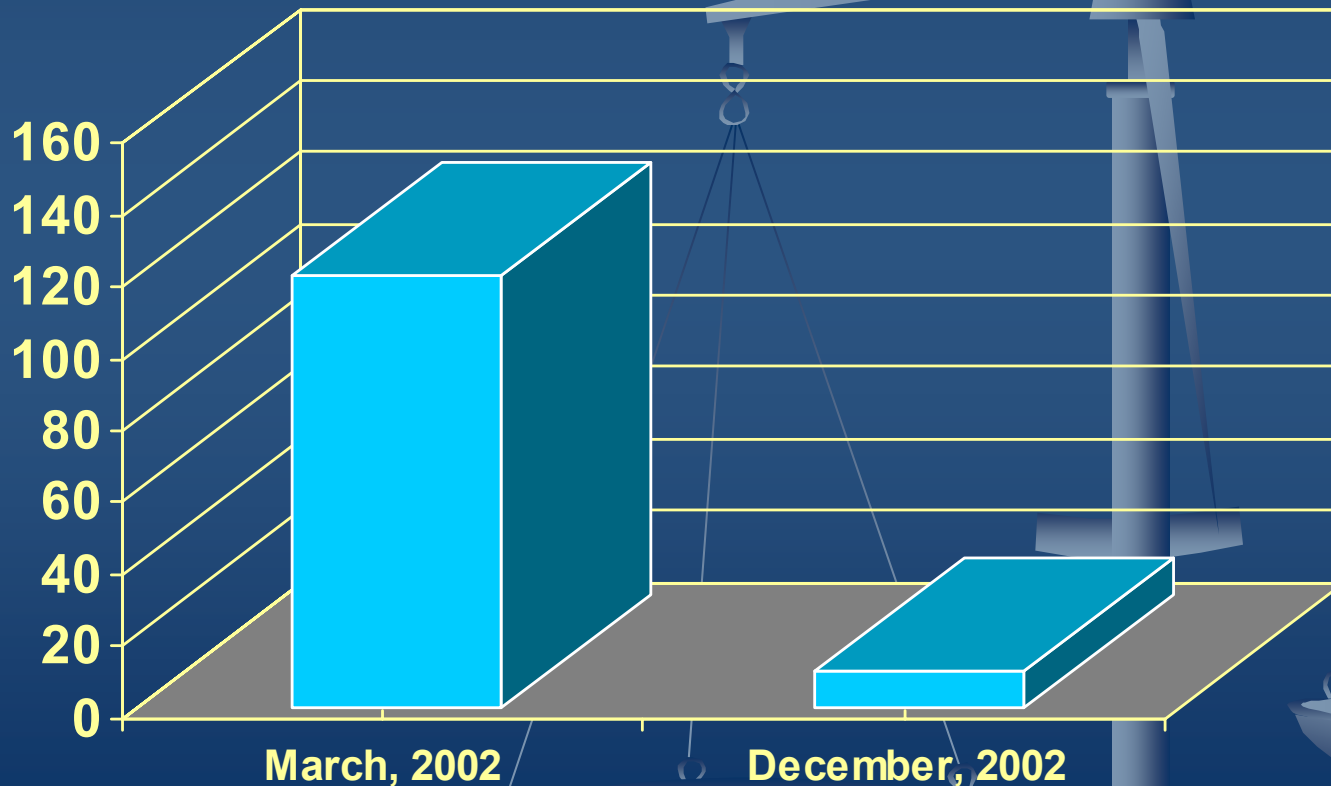

Formal Common Carrier Complaint Matters Pending More Than 12 Months

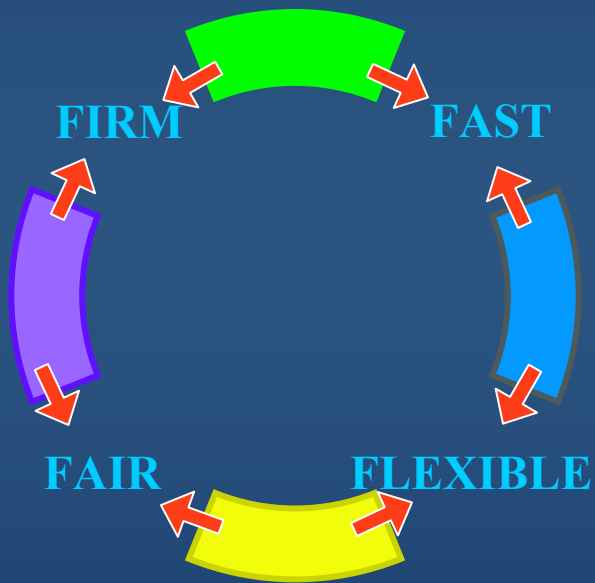
