FCC and NTIA Reports on the Status of the DTV Transition and Prospects for June 12, 2009

The list of stations that may be dark for some period of time after June 12, 2009 has been revised to delete two stations that were included in error, one station that has now completed construction of its digital facility, and one station whose license has been cancelled, reducing the number from 35 to 31. The revised list is attached to this Addendum.

As stations report success in their efforts to complete their digital facilities by June 13, we will adjust our records. These future adjustments to the list of stations that may be dark, or "silent," for some period of time after June 12, 2009, will be made on the Master List of all full power stations, which will be posted on the FCC's DTV.gov website at <a href="http://www.dtv.gov/FULL\_POWER\_STATIONS\_LIST.xls">http://www.dtv.gov/FULL\_POWER\_STATIONS\_LIST.xls</a>. Stations that are permanently dark and whose licenses are cancelled will be removed from the Master List.
