On June 13, 2000, America Online, Inc. ("AOL") presented a demonstration of its AOLTV product at a session attended by certain members of the Commission's staff. The presentation consisted of a demonstration of AOLTV's enhanced television features, as well as a discussion of the benefits AOLTV will deliver to consumers and the television industry. As described, the benefits of AOLTV is based on open standards and consumer choice, and the benefits of AOLTV include: enhancing television viewing with interactivity; bringing popular features of AOL to the television viewing experience; making television easier to
