On July 17, 2000, America Online, Inc. ("AOL") and Time Warner Inc. ("Time Warner") jointly submitted their narrative response (accompanied by a separate document production) to the June 23, 2000 letter from Ms. Royce Dickens, Deputy Chief, Policy and Rules Division, the Cable Services Bureau, requesting certain documents and information. As set forth in that production, AOL indicated that certain agreements identified as responsive to the information and document request were the subject of confidentiality provisions and would be produced once AOL has provided the requisite notices and after expiration of required brief waiting periods or receipt of required approvals.
