Dear Ms. Roman-Salas:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, this letter provides notice of a January 3, 2000 oral *ex parte* presentation by Andrew Jay Schwartzman of Media Access Project in a telephone conversation with William J. Friedman Legal Advisor to the Chairman.

Mr. Schwartzman urged that the Commission should direct that any order granting the AOL/Time Warner applications should be conditioned on assurances that local and regional ISP's be afforded access. He stated that this would cause minimal disruption to AOL/Time Warner while advancing the Commission's public interest objectives of diversity and localism.
