Dear Ms. Salas:

On December 20, 2000, Preston Padden, Senior Vice President of Government Relations, and Marsha MacBride, Vice President of Government Relations for The Walt Disney Company ("Disney") and Lawrence Sidman of Verner, Liipfert, Bernhard, McPherson & Hand, Chtd., counsel to Disney, met with Kathryn Brown, Chief of Staff to Chairman Kennard, to discuss the Commission's review of the application for license transfer in the above captioned proceeding.

During the course of the meeting, Disney reviewed concerns previously communicated to the Commission in its Comments, Reply Comments and prior *ex parte* filings concerning the potential of a merged AOL/Time Warner to impede the development of a competitive market for Interactive Television services. In particular, Disney focused on the importance of continuing Commission monitoring and oversight of any actions by AOL/Time Warner to discriminate against unaffiliated content providers and to deprive consumers of unfettered choice among Interactive Television services, regardless of their ownership. In that regard, Disney underscored the centrality of the availability of remedies and enforcement mechanisms within the FCC's jurisdiction as a safeguard against discriminatory behavior.
