

Dear Ms. Salas:

On January 3, 2001 Jon Englund, Vice President, Policy and Government Affairs, Excite@Home Corporation, spoke by telephone to David Goodfriend, legal advisor to Commissioner Ness, and George Bell, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Excite@Home, spoke by telephone to Jay Friedman, senior legal advisor to Commissioner Tristani. In those calls, Mr. Englund and Mr. Bell described Excite@Home's perspective on interoperability for instant messaging, and stressed that any Commission approval of the Time Warner, Inc./America Online, Inc. merger must include meaningful and enforceable conditions to address the problem of non-interoperability of IM.
