On behalf of Time Warner Inc. ("Time Warner") and America Online, Inc. ("AOL"), submitted herewith pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules are an original and one copy of this notice regarding a permitted oral *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding. On October 27, 2000, representatives of Time Warner and AOL met with members of the Commission's staff to discuss the contents of certain confidential documents produced concurrently pursuant to the Protective Order in this proceeding, as modified.

Attending the meeting on behalf of Time Warner were Glenn Britt, President, Time Warner Cable; Marc Apfelbaum, Senior Vice President and General Counsel, Time Warner Cable; Catherine R. Nolan, Time Warner Vice President, Law and Public Policy; and Arthur H. Harding of Fleischman and Walsh, L.L.P. Attending on behalf on AOL was Peter D. Ross of Wiley, Rein & Fielding. Attending on behalf of the Commission were Jim Bird, Pieter Van Leeuwen, and Joel Rabinovitz, Office of General Counsel; and Royce Dickens, Cable Services Bureau.

Time Warner outlined the terms of its affiliation agreements with Road Runner, as well as



affiliation terms being discussed in ongoing negotiations with numerous unaffiliated ISPs, both national players and smaller regional providers. Time Warner demonstrated that terms being offered to ISPs are reasonable and do not discriminate based on affiliation. Time Warner emphasized that the proposed ISP term sheets have been offered as a starting point for productive negotiations, and that Time Warner Cable remains open to any ideas an ISP might propose to establish a mutually advantageous business relationship.
