Time Warner Inc. ("Time Warner") herein produces certain confidential documents that
have been requested by FCC staff. One copy of all such confidential documents is being

In addition, as requested by FCC staff, Time Warner has reviewed the files of relevant
Time Warner personnel and has discovered no documents, created since the public announcement
of the proposed merger, whether by Time Warner or any third party, concerning instant



messaging, presence detection protocols and/or buddy lists. As set forth in the response to question 3.13 to FCC Document and Information Request No. 3, Time Warner has excluded from the scope of this search any filings made jointly with AOL to government authorities in connection with the merger approval process. Moreover, as discussed with FCC staff, Time Warner has excluded any financial analysts' reports that may address such matters, several of which have been submitted to the FCC in connection with the parties' Supplemental Information filing on March 21, 2000.
