

Dear Senators Leiberman and Dodd and the rest of the CT Congressional delegation,

I am a current Dishnetwork user and let me share with you how much of a pain it is not to have our local channels on the Satellite. I can get ABC & NBC affiliates via antenna, but cannot get CBS & FOX at all. Local FOX granted me the waiver to get a New York feed, however WFSB, (local CBS Affiliate) has refused the waiver despite my personal efforts with the management of the station including Mary Moonen, programming director & Al Bova, the General Manager. They keep denying me the opportunity to get CBS feed from New York based on a Zip Code map that tells them that my residence should have a strong enough signal to be captured with the local antenna and keep telling them that despite having a very powerful antenna, I still cannot get WFSB signal. I have even challenged them to do a signal strength test at my residence at my expense to see it first hand that there is no signal at my residence and this is a 'white area' and thus qualifies for waiver to receive network feed from NY.

If the merger goes through, a combined company can supply local channels in our State.
