On Monday, April 1, 2002, Cheryl Crate of Pegasus Communications, Kathleen Wallman and Brett Tarnutzer of Wallman Strategic Consulting LLC, and Roger Rusch of TelAstra met with the members of the FCC's merger review team listed below. The meeting was scheduled at the request of FCC staff in order to provide follow-up information regarding the affidavit filed by Roger Rusch as a part of Pegasus' petition to deny in this docket. Mr. Rusch reviewed his affidavit and the topics addressed therein, including local into local broadcasting, spot beams, and satellite design. We also discussed the merits of making use of the technological advancements discussed in the affidavit to provide local into local service in all 210 DMAs. In addition, Mr. Rusch addressed new technologies that provide more efficient use of spectrum, including turbo coding, 8PSK modulation, compression and personal video recorders.
