**CHADMOORE WIRELESS GROUP, INC. AND NEXTEL

Chadmoore Wireless Group, Inc. ("Chadmoore") and Nextel Communications, Inc. ("Nextel") have filed the following applications under Section 310(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ seeking Commission approval to assign 1,062 licenses in the 800 MHz Specialized Mobile Radio ("SMR") and the 900 MHz SMR service held by Chadmoore to Nextel.
