Dear Ms. Salas:

This letter is filed at the request of counsel for Jordan-Soldier Telephone Company ("JS") to clarify a statement made in paragraph 4 of the Opposition to Petition to Deny filed December 1, 2000 by VoiceStream PCS BTA I Corporation ("VoiceStream") in the referenced proceeding. Undersigned counsel for VoiceStream hereby clarifies that it was in a return call by undersigned counsel to an earlier voicemail from JS' counsel that the subject of JS' desired spectrum access was first discussed. The voicemail from JS' counsel notified undersigned counsel that a petition was being filed. In subsequently discussing this matter with counsel for JS, it appears that counsel have different views as to what each intended to communicate on the return call from undersigned counsel. VoiceStream's only point, however, was that prior to that conversation, there had been no contact between JS and VoiceStream on the subject of spectrum access.
