

PROFESSIONAL BIOGRAPHY FOR PAUL W. GARNETT

Paul Garnett is Director, Regulatory Policy for CTIA-The Wireless Association™, where he is responsible for coordinating regulatory issues for the association affecting the mobile wireless industry. These issues include universal service, intercarrier compensation, local competition, consumer issues, and spectrum matters.

Prior to joining CTIA, Mr. Garnett served in several positions at the Federal Communications Commission. Mr. Garnett served as Legal Counsel to the Wireline Competition Bureau Chief and as Acting Assistant Chief and Attorney-Advisor in the Telecommunications Access Policy Division. While at the FCC, Mr. Garnett was responsible for issues relating to the receipt of universal service support in competitive areas, the payment of universal service contributions, and the high-cost universal service support mechanisms.

Before joining the FCC, Mr. Garnett was an Associate at Swidler Berlin Shereff Friedman, LLP in Washington, D.C., in their telecommunications practice group. Mr. Garnett received his J.D. *cum laude* from the Catholic University of America and his B.A. from Union College. Prior to law school, Mr. Garnett was a Staff Consultant for Price Waterhouse LLP in a practice group specializing in the privatization of government-owned telecommunications monopolies.
